Blind Harry is thought to have lived from 1440 to 1493. Little is known about him. His one major achievement was to gather and record in writing stories about Wallace. He sang or recited these stories in verse form, and was well received at the Renaissance Court of James IV.

William Hamilton of Gilbertfield was a poet and soldier. All but forgotten now, it was he who brought Wallace back to the attention with his hugely popular 'translation' of Blind Harry's original poem.

Elsbeth King is the Director of the Stirling Smith Art Gallery & Museum, which has a large collection of Wallace memorabilia and hosted the exhibition 'Scotland's Liberator- The Life and Legacy of William Wallace- throughout 1997 marking the 700 anniversary of the Battle of Stirling Bridge.
