Some pieces, like Matilde Herrera's "Eduardito Doesn't Like the Police," about the Argentine military dictatorship, focus on more specific political situations. But throughout the anthology, the most striking idea, eloquently and effectively communicated, is one of nostalgic loneliness, a sad and wistful longing for connection.
